Three Year Outlook and Goals

Year 1: 2010-2011

1. Goals
 1. To increase transparency and efficiency in running tryouts and organizing teams
 - Changed the tryout structure to maximize the number of coaches evaluating players at each session.
 - Improved the efficiency of creating teams by creating a club email account and using email to gather player commitments.
 2. Implement a new fee structure to increase coaching funds to attract and improve AWSC's coaching personnel
 - Change of fee structure by age group to align our organization for tax purposes and allow funds to be available to hire new coaches.
 - Use funds available to get all coaches adequate licensing to prepare for OYSAN licensing requirements.
 3. Organizational/facility improvements
 - Revamp of current website to streamline information for individuals
 - Begin new turf management program at AW Complex

Year 2: 2011-2012

1. Goals
 1. Enhance the number of programming options available to all players
 - Educate players on additional opportunities like ODP and increase the number of participants in the program in the fall.
 - Add optional third sessions for all teams U11 and up (run by DOPD) and U10 and below (run by DOY) throughout the year.
 2. Increase the size of the club and number of paid staff
 - Improve advertising and outreach to potential U11-U9s to increase club numbers to ensure fielding at least one team in all age groups U9-U14 again.
 - Net one additional paid staff coach for the year.
 - Hire a replacement for our departing DOA and change the job to Director of Youth (DOY) overseeing U10s and below.

 - Handbook and bylaws review needed to bring documents up with current practices.
 - Change process for Mud Hens volunteer sign up.
 - Move to online calendar process for fall and spring seasons.
